



YOUR agreement in principle

The agreement in principle with CBC / Radio-Canada will be submitted to the 2,800 members of the STTRC-CSN and debated at a general meeting on September 25. The Bargaining Committee, the Union Bureau and the Union Council are recommending ratification.

A few hours after reaching the agreement with the employer on Tuesday, our Bargaining Committee presented its terms to the Union Bureau. On the following day, the agreement was presented to the Union Council. Both bodies endorsed the Bargaining Committee's proposal to recommend ratification of the agreement by the membership on September 25.

Local meetings

The members of the Bargaining Committee and the Union Bureau will hit the road next week to visit all CBC / Radio-Canada workplaces and discuss the details of the agreement they are recommending with union members.

The success of the tour will depend on the attendance of STTRC-CSN members at every station. The tentative agreement on a new collective agreement affects all of us.

We hope these meetings will give everyone a good understanding of the issues and the results of the work done by our Bargaining Committee since it was elected at a general meeting 18 months ago.

The Union Bureau and the Bargaining Committee join their voices in saluting the dedication, determination and deep commitment of all CBC / Radio-Canada employees. We couldn't have done it without you!
